


An online form with the above questions was created and circulated to all the students. A total of 356 samples were collected and the data was tabulated. The graph given below depicts the questions for which the students have given the highest rating (4). It is evident that, from the graph enclosed, students have given feedback that all the questions are satisfactory and more than 50% of students have given highest rating to some of the questions. However, for the principle of continuous improvement, all the twenty questions are analyzed in depth.

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?











5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers









8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth





















17. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good









This is a graphical representation of students’ feedback from highest response to the lowest response.





Students have appreciated their highest for the **How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?** and the second in order is the **What percentage of teachers use ITC tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc, while teaching.** All the questions given in the table below are performing satisfactorily, and of all the samples collected, questions numbered 1 to 8 have been given the highest rating . However, questions numbered 9 to 20 are performing less. The report will be placed before the concerned authorities for continuous improvement in the areas where the questions are underperforming.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE UNDERPERFORMING QUESTIONS

- 1) Teachers need to review and discuss the performance of the students post internal assessment for the purpose of maintaining transparency.
- 2) Mentor-mentee program to be strengthened.
- 3) Teachers to enhance the use of ICT tools and advanced audio visual aids.
- 4) Innovative teaching methods can be tried by teachers.
- 5) Students to be well oriented about the course and program outcomes along with the relevant career opportunities.
- 6) The institution must encourage the students to participate in student exchange programs and field visits to provide them necessary exposure needed.
- 7) Advanced performers should be encouraged to explore more opportunities.
- 8) Institution must create an environment for the overall improvement in the personality of the students.
- 9) Extracurricular activities are to be promoted by the teaching faculty.

The above recommendations have been placed before the IQAC Committee to resolve the concerns observed from the Student Satisfaction Survey. The IQAC Committee will strive to achieve better standards and create an environment for holistic development of the students.



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
