- 1. Title: Comprehensive Dental Care Clinic
- 2. Objectives:
 - a) To train the post graduate students and interns in planning comprehensive dental care to patients
 - b) To provide co-ordinated treatment with proficiency in clinical and technical procedure with an interdisciplinary perspective
 - c) To train the students on communication and patient management skills
 - d) To train the students in maintenance of patient records

4. Mode of training:

Didactic method with MS PowerPoint presentations, demonstrations and hands-on exercises

At the commencement of clinical posting of the students, the case history taking was taught through didactic method of teaching using PowerPoint presentations followed by group discussion among the students. Various case scenarios were discussed and doubts were clarified. Steps in planning comprehensive treatment plans were elaborately discussed and debated based on evidence-based dentistry Subsequently, the students were asked to demonstrate their skis patienc management, communication and case history taking. All the treatments were carried out under the direct supervision of the specialty faculty, and faculty of Public Health Dentistry.

Comprehensive Dental Care Clinic

The definition of comprehensive dentistry is a concept that includes not only traditional treatment of dental disease but also prevention and early detection. Comprehensive dental care takes into consideration of all the points of maintaining good oral health and minimizing the risk factors that can cause problems to it. It includes the restoration, repair of teeth and most of the oral cavity that has already been damaged due to aging or some accidental injury.

Since comprehensive dentistry deals with the protection of the oral cavity, it is protecting the organs below it in the digestive system from the effects of bacterial infection. Comprehensive dentistry thus deals with maintenance of all the tissues and bones of the mouth, which includes gums, teeth, jawbone, and tongue.

As part of patient's comprehensive examination, the dental specialist visualises examine the soft tissues of the oral cavity and surrounding muscles for changes and abnormalities.



TITLE: ESTHETICS- THE ART OF ILLUSION

OBJECTIVE: With the ever-growing consciousness among the general population about various cosmetic enhancement procedures , dental esthetic restorative procedures has gained paramount importance over the recent years.

INDICATION FOR ESTHETIC PROCEDURES

- 1.Caries
- 2.Occlusal disharmony of teeth
- 3.Loss of tooth substrate
- 4.Discolouration
- 5. Minor abnormalities
- 6.Missing teeth

METHODS: Esthetic procedures are technique sensitive and mainly depend on the extent of damage to be built up as well as the operator's skill. The following steps are followed:

Tooth Preparation

Cleaning of the tooth

Etching of tooth

Applying opaquer

Buildup of the cervical layer

Buildup of the Body Layer

Aplication of Tints

Buildup of the Incisal enamel

Placement of Proximal enamel

Students were taught about esthetic restoration in a lecture, followed by demonstration of the steps involved on typhodont teeth. After the demonstration students were made to perform composite restoration and then use the composite polishing kit. Following this they were allowed to perform the same on patients. Post completion of treatment, it was evaluated by respected staff members.
