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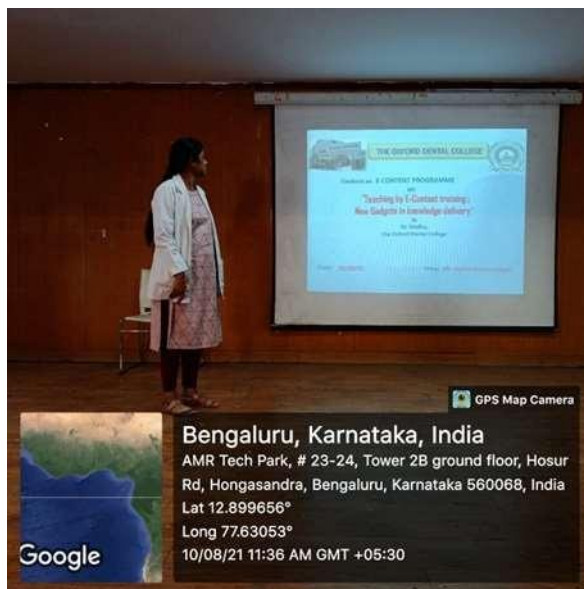
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OUTCOME ANALYSIS –

There was a positive response from the audience during interactive session of the program. The queries from the staff were effectively answered by the speaker. The programme was followed by lunch and valedictory programme.



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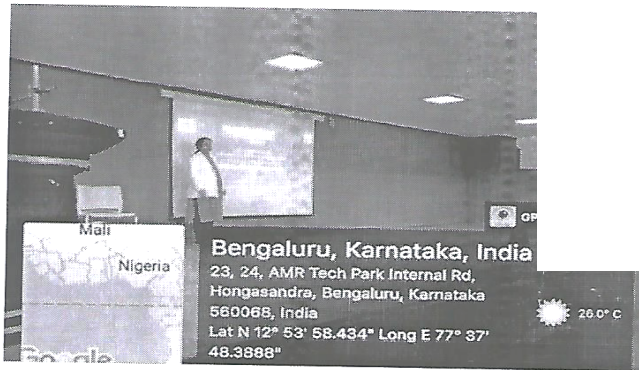
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
