

Comprehensive Dental Care Clinic

The definition of comprehensive dentistry is- a concept that includes not only traditional treatment of dental disease but also prevention and early detection. Comprehensive dental care takes into consideration of all the points of maintaining good oral health and minimizing the risk factors that can cause problems to it. It includes the restoration, repair of teeth and most of the oral cavity that has already been damaged due to aging or some accidental injury.

Since comprehensive dentistry deals with the protection of the oral cavity, it is protecting the organs below it in the digestive system from the effects of bacterial infection. Comprehensive dentistry thus deals with maintenance of all the tissues and bones of the mouth, which includes gums, teeth, jawbone, and tongue.

As part of patient's comprehensive examination, the dental specialist visualises examine the soft tissues of the oral cavity and surrounding muscles for changes and abnormalities.

For Comprehensive Dentistry at The Oxford Dental College, an important piece of commitment to comprehensive care is that each patient is treated as a unique, whole person. The dental specialist looks at the mouth being connected to, influenced by and influencing the whole body. Factors such as general health, medications, state of nutrition, problems with stress from work or life, as well as patient's own self-care habits are all important in understanding what is happening with oral health. The treatment is being carried out in the Comprehensive dental Unit in the department of Public Health Dentistry.

Specialty clinic in Geriatric dentistry

Title: Specialty clinic in Geriatric dentistry

Introduction: Geriatrics is derived from a Greek word "geron" meaning- old man ' and iatros" meaning- healer. The demographic data suggests that there is a huge number of patients above 60 years of age, having greater dental health awareness seeking dental treatment. Geriatric dentistry is the delivery of dental care to older adults involving diagnosis, prevention and treatment of problems associated with normal aging. As oral health care professionals we deal with various physiological and pathological wear of tooth, gingival recession, presence of restorations and age related odontometric changes. Consideration of overall clinical and oral health context of aging patients is important in order to provide optimum dental care. Hence this training aims at management of geriatric patients.

Hands on - 2 hours

Students work on extracted teeth under the guidance of staff.

Topics include restoration of wear lesions using composite and glass ionomer cement, access preparation, location of canals, cleaning and shaping, obturation on extracted teeth.

Patient management -

Under rubber dam isolation restorative and endodontic therapy is performed. **Guidelines**

- Short and early morning appointments.
- Pillows for back/ neck comfort
- Mouth props/ Bite blocks
- Magnification and transillumination to identify calcified canals.
- Rotary NITI instrumentation to reduce treatment time.

Equipment's and instruments -

- I. Restorative for composites different shade selection methods such as classic 3D shade guide and spectrometer. Light cure unit with halogen, LED, and variable light emitting unit such as radio meter with various intensity. Diagnostic instruments, Teflon coated instruments, various finishing and polishing instruments like discs, cups and points. Evaluation of occlusion with fully adjustable articulator and face bow transfer.
- II. Endodontics Digital radiographs, various anesthetic techniques like the stabident local anesthetic system and X-tip, endo access bur, Ultrasonic tips, endomotor, electronic apex locator, endodontic hand and rotary instruments, obturation units.

Training Method

Most elderly patients are medically compromised and are on medication. Most commonly seen medical conditions are-

Diabetes Mellitus-

Patients with diabetes who are well controlled medically and free of complications are indicated for dental treatment. Detail information regarding most recent test results, frequency of hypoglycemic episodes, medication, dosage and timing should be recorded.

- Appointments should be scheduled at early morning.
- ▶ Before the procedure it has to be ensured that the patient has eaten normally and taken medication as usual.
- > It is always advisable to consult a patient physician before any surgical procedure.

Hypertension-

A. Mild to Moderate Hypertension

Physician consultation, stress reduction protocol, decrease the amount of adrenaline in LA, local haemostatic measures carefully taken to avoid undue

haemorrhage, avoid rapid posture changes as it can lead to orthostatic hypotension and syncope.

B. Severe Hypertension

Physician consultation, postpone till blood pressure is controlled, premedication.

Cardiovascular Diseases-

- A. Patient with Unstable Angina or With Recent Myocardial Infarction (<6 Months)
 - Consultation with physician
 - Avoid elective dental care
- > Ensure excellent pain control with LA- avoid vasoconstrictors, although small amount epinephrine may be tolerated.
- Prophylactic nitroglycerine sublingually before procedure.
- B. Patient with Stable Angina or History of Myocardial Infarction (6 Months or Longer)
 - > Treatment plan should include low stress protocols and shorter appointments (morning)
 - Pretreatment vital signs
 - Semi supine chair position
 - > Prophylactic antibiotic may be necessary for patients with history of high-risk cardiac conditions while undertaking endodontic therapy.
- Restorative/Esthetic dentistry- demonstration and hands on training in A. restorative techniques. Esthetic rehabilitation is undertaken after proper occlusal and esthetic analysis to achieve predictable results.
- Endodontics –under magnification demonstration and hands on training on B. challenges encountered in endodontic treatment. Proper diagnosis, good quality radiographs, challenges posed with anesthesia, pulp space calcification and post endodontic restoration are a part of the training to achieve successful endodontic treatment.

Evaluation of Learning -

The trainee is evaluated whether learning objective has been achieved. Chair side viva and discussion of cases on treatment planning and prognosis is done to evaluate learning.

Specialty Clinic in Management of Especially Abled Patients

Title: Specialty Clinic in Management of Especially Abled Patients

Introduction:

Numerous conditions require special patient management. The dental professionals have to endeavor to treat each patient as an individual with unique needs that may require modifying routine procedures. People with special needs are those whose dental care is complicated by a physical, mental or social disability. A well taken past medical and dental history is of utmost importance for such cases.

Learning objectives:

- To be efficient in evaluation of especially abled patients. 1.
- II. To be competent in management of especially abled patients.

Guidelines when working with especially abled patients

- ١. Visual Impairment:
- a. Lead the patient by standing slightly in front; the patient will hold onto your bent arm near the elbow for guidance.
- b. Indicate charges in the floor and prepare a path to dental chair that is free of
- c. Always describe procedures to the patient in a step by step fashion using patient's own language to provide the instructions.
- d. Patient is partially sighted: Avoid glare of light.
- e. The dental radiographer must never gesture to another person in presence of the person who is blind.
- Hearing Impairment 11.
 - a. Face the patient: Remove your mask. Speak normally. Pause more frequently than usual.
 - b. Avoid sitting in front of window or bright light which may cast a shadow.
 - c. Use a pencil and paper to communicate oral care recommendations.
 - d. Avoid background noise.
 - e. Ask the patient to turn off hearing aid when using high pitch powered scaling and tooth brush devices.
- III. Mobility Impairment
 - a. If the person is in a wheelchair and does not have use of lower limb radiographer may offer help in transferring patient from care giver to the dental chair.
 - b. If not possible to shift the patient, perform the procedure in the wheelchair.
- c. Care giver can help the patient to hold the film if upper limb is not in use.

d. Short exposure time should be used to minimize image unsharpness due to increased patient movement.

Evaluation of learning:

The trainee is evaluated whether the learning objective has been achieved with chair side discussion of cases on treatment planning and prognosis. It would be expected that routine endodontic therapy may have varied response on the especially abled patient and the success of the treatment depends to a great deal on the further maintenance done by the patient or his care giver. The clinician must be mindful of especially abled patients emotional and physical needs to ensure that treatment is as comfortable as possible.





India had 275 million current tobacco users in the year 2009-2010. An estimated one million people die every year due to tobacco related diseases in India. In order to reduce the impact of tobacco related morbidity and mortality, we need a combination of strategies aimed at avoiding initiation of tobacco by the non-users and cessation of tobacco use among current users, Thus, tobacco cessation is an initiative to reduce the mortality and morbidity related to tobacco usage.

Tobacco cessation centres intend to create awareness among the general public about the negative effects of tobacco and about tobacco cessation through awareness programs, exhibits training programs on tobacco cessation for various professionals. It is a service run by the Public Health Department of The Oxford Dental College in order to aid persons wishing to quit smoking or chewing tobacco and tobacco containing products.

The centre is designed as per the guidelines stipulated by the Dental Council of India. It is located in the ground floor of The Oxford Dental College, where interns are posted on rotatory basis daily and post graduate students from Public Health Department and Oral Medicine and Radiology are posted twice a week. To maintain privacy, it is made sure that the space for counselling is secluded at the same time being well ventilated.

All the departments especially the department of Oral Medicine refer the patients who are identified as tobacco users to the tobacco cessation centre. The interns and PGs are trained in tobacco cessation before being posted to TCC. Opportunities are also provided to the students to undergo training at premier institutes like. NIMHANS. Here the interns and PG students undertake a detailed evaluation, which focuses on the severity of patient's addiction and use, their motivation to quit, assessment of their current lung-function and the amount of carbon-monoxide in their body using a smokerlyser. The severity of nicotine dependence is assessed by Fagerstom scale which is included in the tobacco consumption record. They are then counselled regarding appropriate strategies to aid quitting, which is usually a combination of medicines to reduce the urge and craving for nicotine as well as behavioural strategies to deal with the consequences of quitting. The services offered at the clinic include individual intervention in the form of behavioural counselling, motivational interviewing, nicotine replacement therapy.

Apart from these interventions, a well-stocked printed IEC material is also available in both English and Kannada for those patients who are in the midst of cessation or for educating the public about the deleterious effects of tobacco. These pamphlets are distributed to the patients and their caregivers regularly to keep the information flowing constantly. Also, the television situated in the health education museum relentlessly plays videos pertaining to tobacco, its effects and ways to deal with it.



Till date, nearly 5-6 patients are being counselled and given pharmacological interventions at the TCC per week. Regular follow-ups are designed to cater to the needs of the individual patients. The screening for precancerous lesions through oral examinations is also conducted and necessary referral to department of Oral Medicine is made.

Not only are tobacco cessation activities carried out in the centre, but also various research activities have been successfully undertaken at the centre. Many dissertations of the post graduate students were set in the TCC. 



The goal of minimally invasive dentistry, or micro dentistry, is to conserve healthy tooth structure. It focuses on prevention, remineralisation, and minimal dentist intervention. Using scientific advances, minimally invasive dentistry allows dentists to perform the least amount of dentistry needed while never removing more of the tooth structure than is required to restore teeth to their normal condition. In addition, in minimally invasive dentistry, dentists use long- lasting dental materials that conserve the maximum tooth structure so the need for future repairs is reduced. Minimum Invasion Dentistry (MID) is defined as a philosophy of professional care, concerned with the occurrence, early detection and earliest possible cure of disease on a micro level, followed by minimally invasive treatment in order to repair irreversible damages caused by such 4disease. Golden Triangle of MID. A thorough understanding and appreciation of the interplay between three critical factors is required to achieve success clinically when using a minimally invasive operative caries management strategy.

It is time for changes in the principles of operative dentistry. The disease should be treated first; the surgical approach should be undertaken only as a last resort and efforts should be made to preserve a maximum amount of sound tooth structure. Minimally invasive endodontics is in the interest of the patient, and preserving tooth structure requires optical magnification aids (surgical microscope), ultrasonic-assisted preparation techniques, modern file systems, and in-depth knowledge of the tooth and root canal anatomy.

Focusing on too much of minimal technique my lead to a higher rate of procedural errors and benefit may be outweighed by poor clinical outcome. Hence, the clinician should strike the right balance between minimal preparation and traditional endodontic preparation with their own pros and cons, thus achieving the objectives of endodontic treatment

Different Methods of Attempting Retreatment

Several techniques have been proposed to remove filling materials from root canal system, including

- Use of endodontic hand files
- Use of heated instruments
- Ultrasonic instruments
- Lasers
- Use of adjunctive solvents

Evaluation Done for Complete Removal of GP Points

- Radiographic method through Diagora and CBCT if required
- Clinical assessment through visual and intraoral examination aided by magnification and illumination
- Through periodontal evaluation

Retreatment Techniques:

- Radiographic assessment is done using CBCT to evaluate the cause of failure.
- GP removal can be done using either chemical solvents such as xylene or endosolve
- In a previously treated teeth with a very good crown structure, Re-rct can be done by penetrating the crown instead of removing it.
- Proper irrigation with 5.25% of NAOCL to be done for 30 mins after cleaning and shaping
- Complete obturation including accessory canals has to be done.

Challenges During Endodontic Retreatment

- Intraradicular infection persisting in the complex apical root canal system
- Extraradicular infection generally in the form of periapical actinimycosis
- Extruded root canal filling
- Cystic lesions
- Ledge formations
- calcifications
