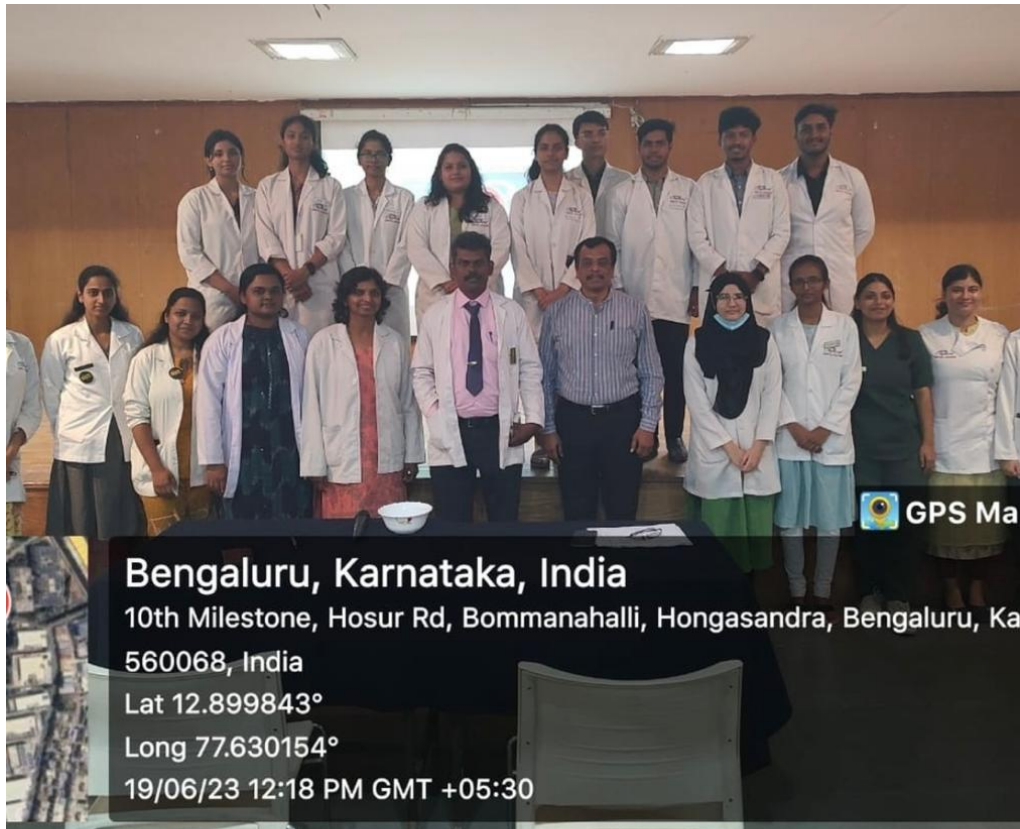

Interdisciplinary Meet was conducted by Department Of Prosthodontics in TODC on 07.11.2023.



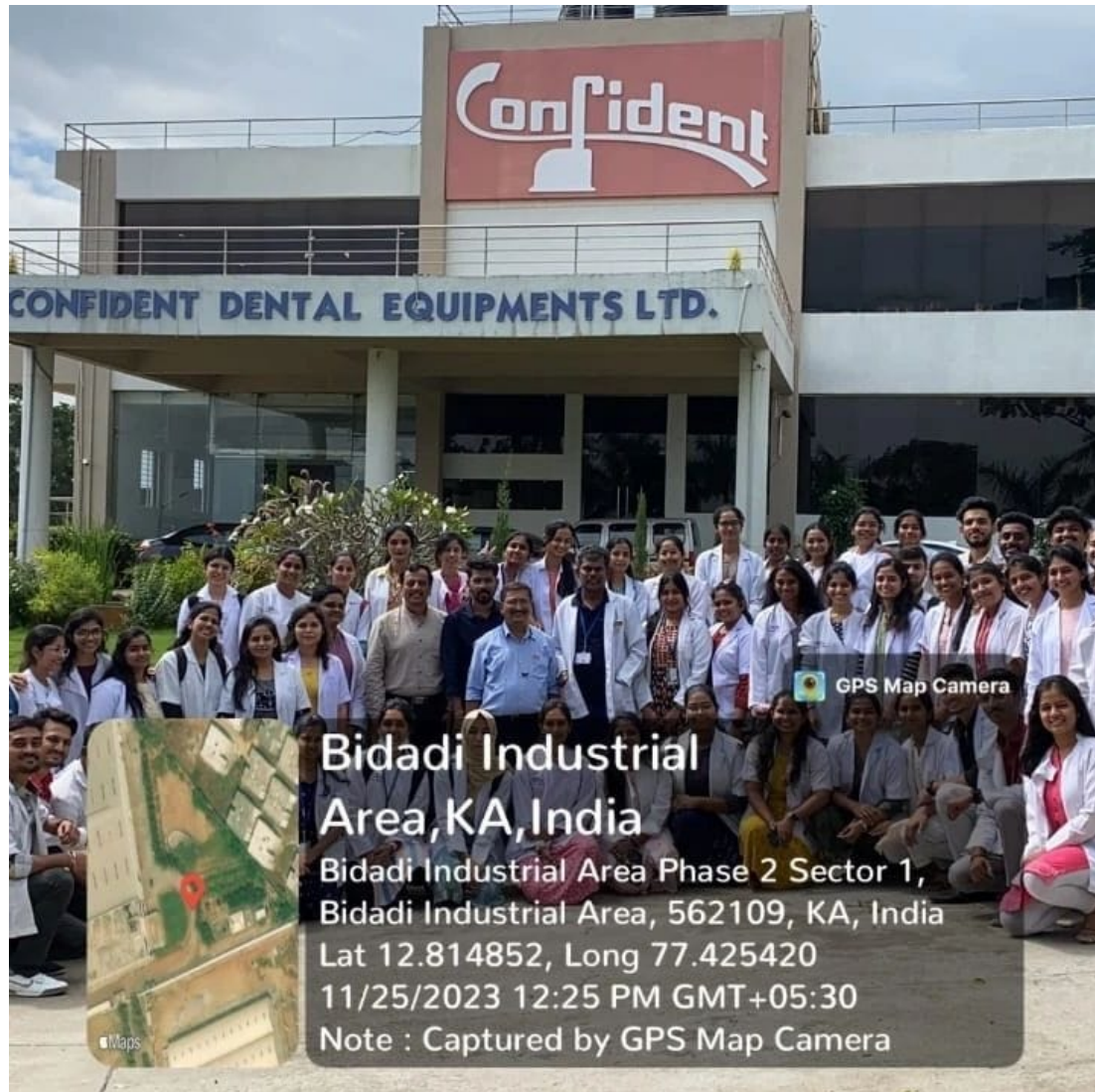

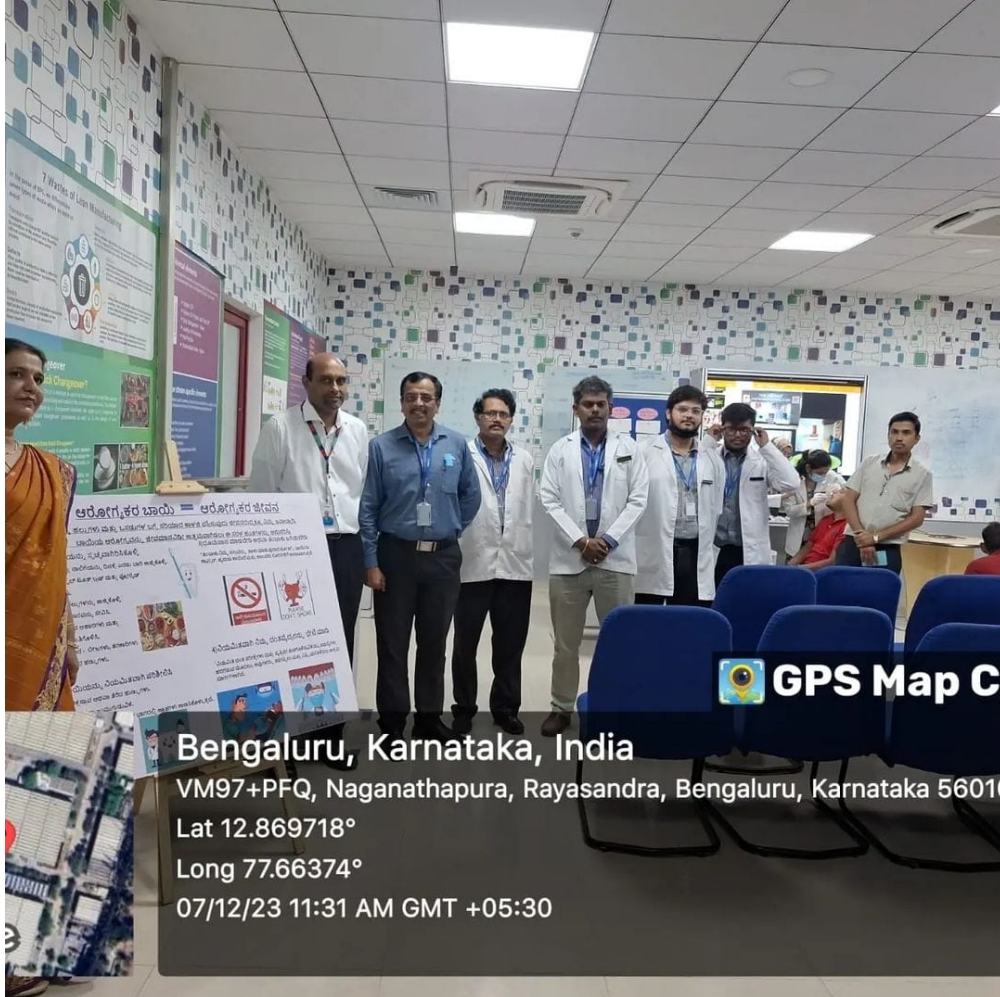
Anti-ragging workshop was conducted by the Anti ragging Committee in TODC on 16.11.2023.

Department of Prosthodontics conducted a debate on the occasion of World Oral Health Day on 20.03.2024 in TODC. A total of 14 participants of four teams participated.



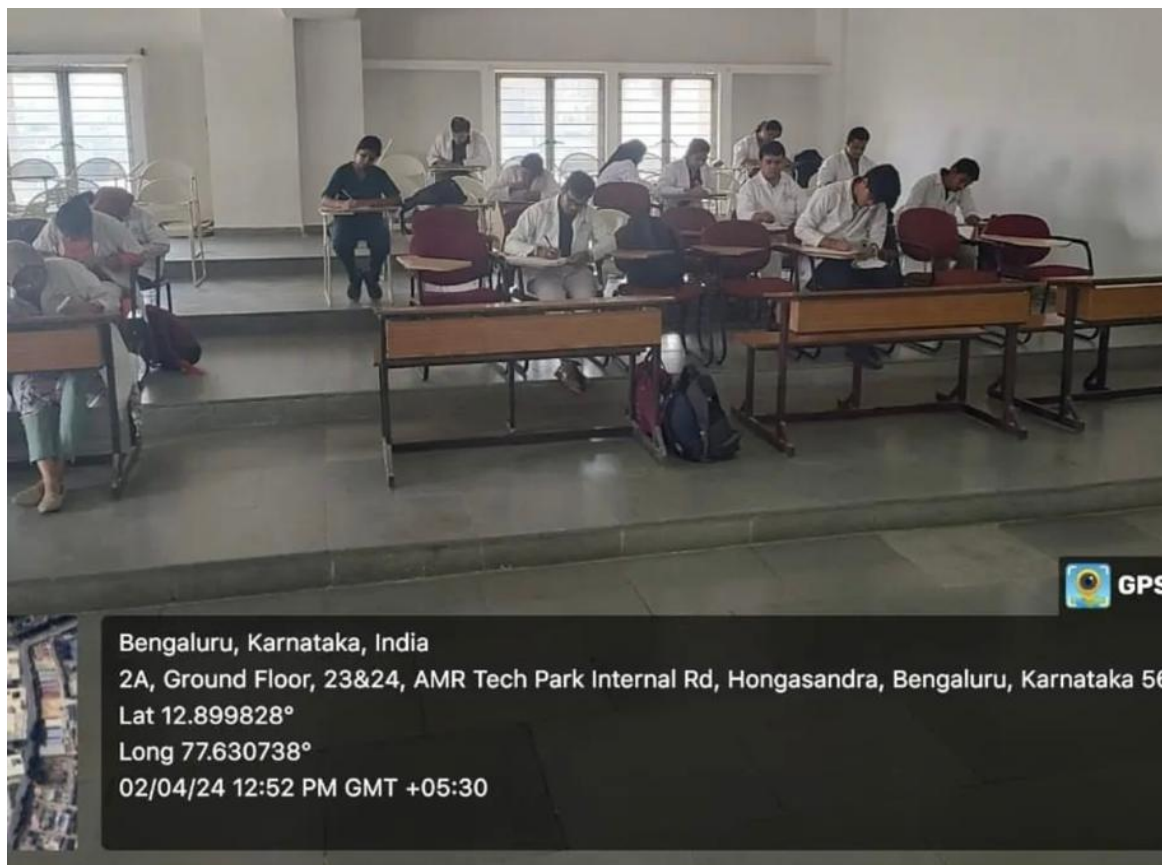
Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology conducted a collage competition in TODC for UG students on the occasion of World Oral Health month on 25.03.2024.
